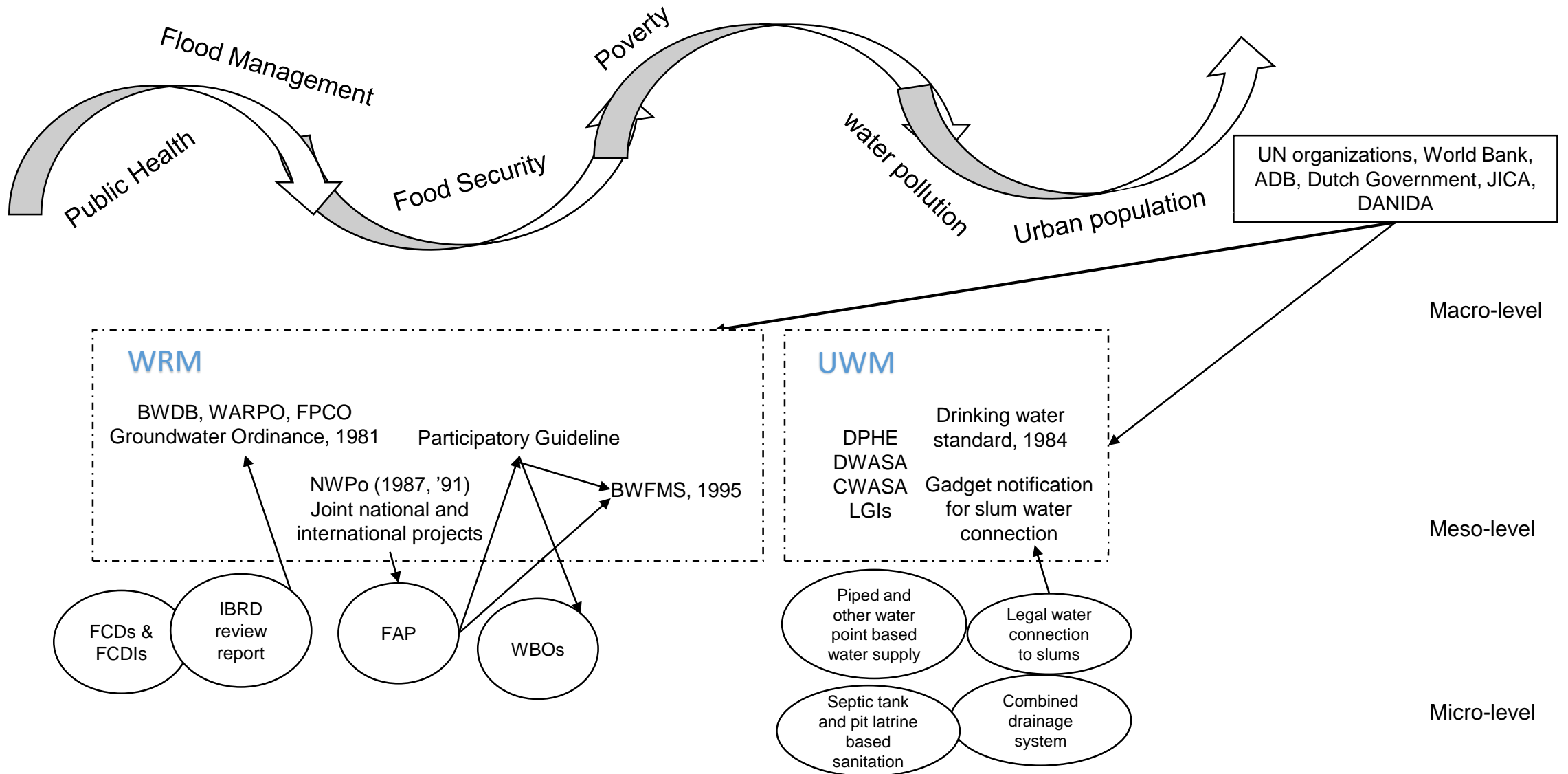

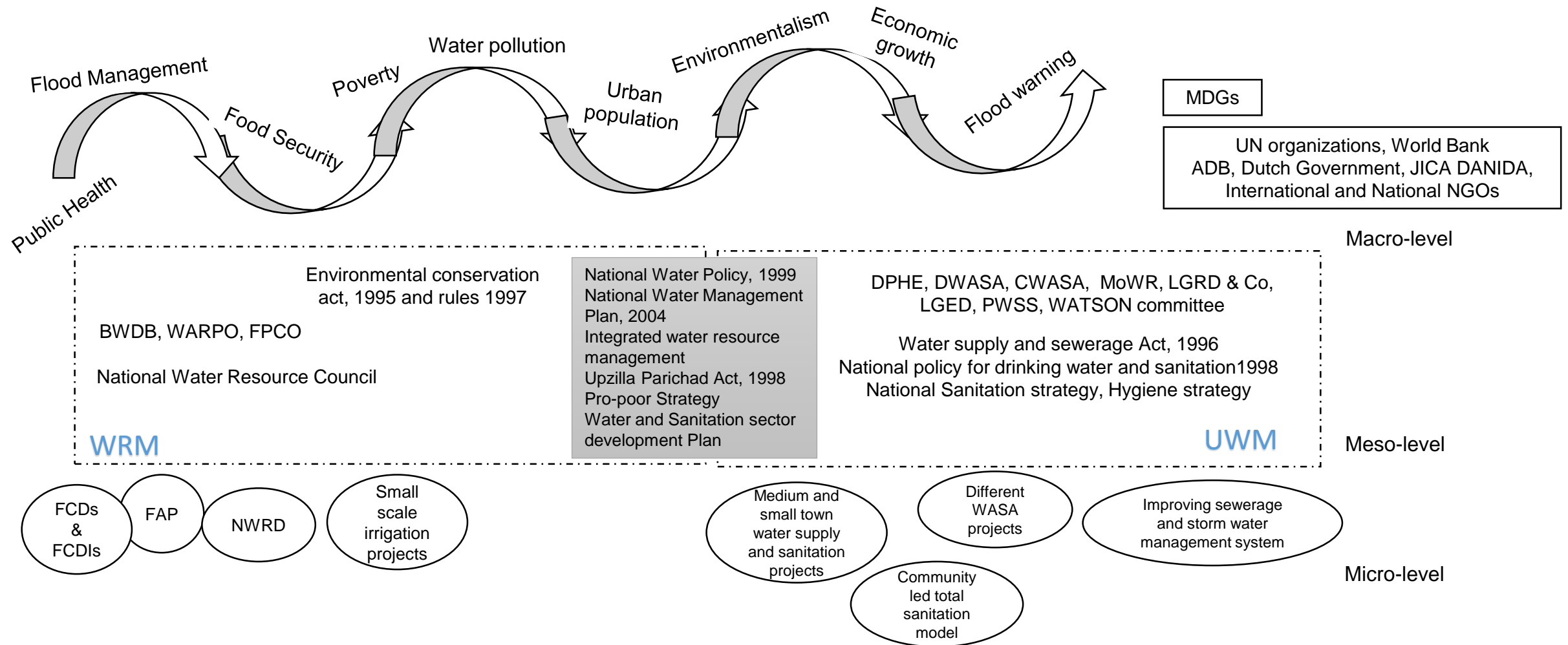
MLP-British period



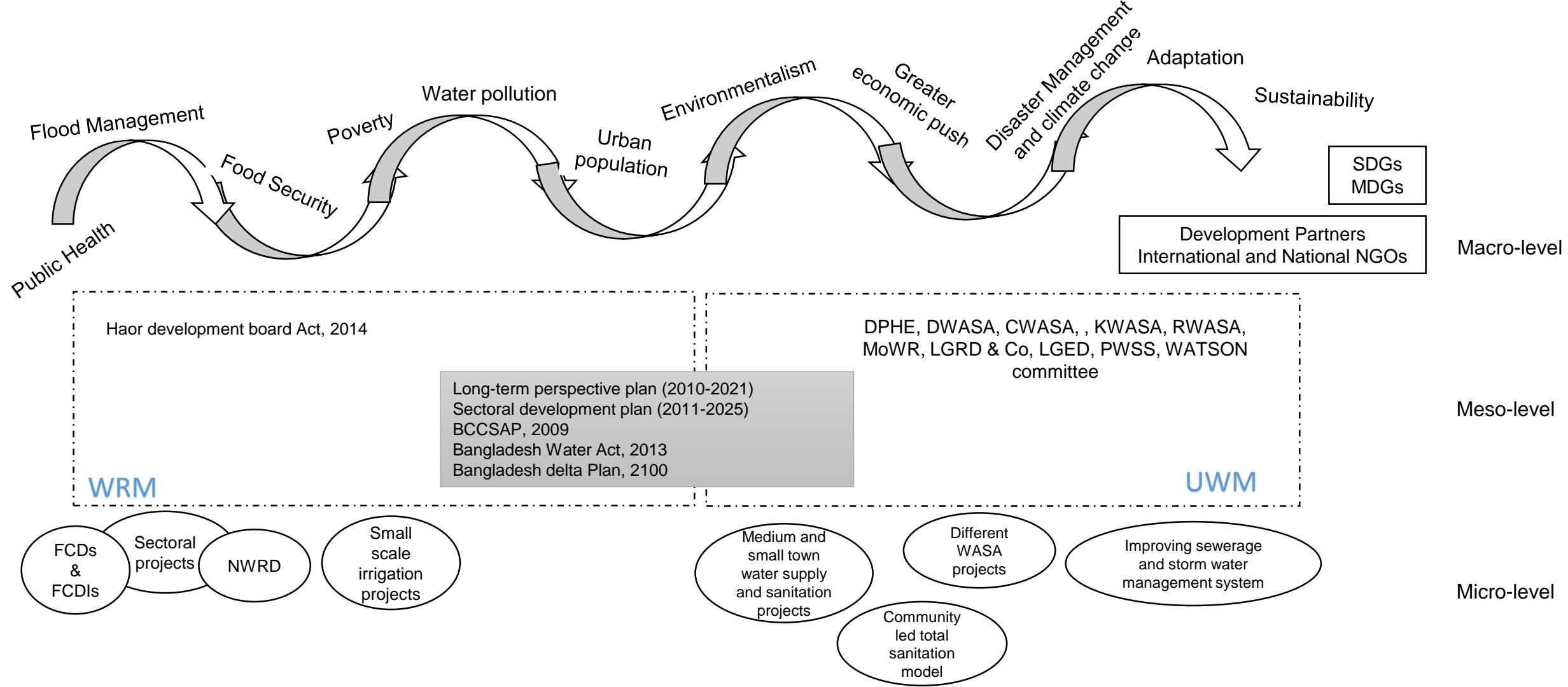
MLP-Pakistan period
